This is the seventh foal from The Iffraaj Dame, she has had five to race, all winners.

This colt was a medium sized foal with good bone and strength. As a yearling he has really grown into a big strong workman style of colt who stands over good ground.

Bred and sold by Trelawney Stud, Ocean Park is a stallion that the farm has a great affinity with. He continues to go from strength to strength and has 10 individual stakes winners to date.

This is a family with plenty of upside. Since the catalogue went to print there have been two winning updates via La Strata and Seajetz.
